Sub: Admission process for 2017-2018.

Sir

1. This is in continuation of this Council's letter dt.5.5.2017 on the above subject (copy enclosed for ready reference).
2. The representatives from a number of pharmacy institutions in Uttar Pradesh visited this Council's office on 20.6.2017 and stated that they are not included in the counselling process for the purpose of admission for the academic session 2017-2018 in the absence of the Pharmacy Council of India approval for that session despite the Council's clarification given in the letter dt.5.5.2017.
3. In this connection, it is again clarified that whenever the Central Council of the Pharmacy Council of India takes a decision to -
 - a) issue notice u/s 13(1) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 for withdrawal of approval.
OR
 - b) withdraw approval u/s 13 of the said Act.
OR
 - c) advise the institution not to make admissions,the same is invariably communicated to the concerned examining authority. As such, such decisions may be available in your organization. Further the decision of various Executive Committees and Central Councils are also placed on Council's website www.pci.nic.in besides lists of institutions approved by PCI which may please be referred to. However, for facilitating easy reference and taking timely action, it is hereby informed that at present there is only one pharmacy institution in Uttar Pradesh; namely - Smt. Fulehra Smarak College of Pharmacy, Ballia which has been advised not to make admission in B.Pharm course. However, the institution has submitted a representation which will be placed in the next Executive Committee of the Council and the action will be taken accordingly.
4. In view of the above position you may suitably organize counseling and admission process to various pharmacy courses in Uttar Pradesh.
